History

A famous natural tourist attraction with an area of 6,100 rai / 9.8 km2, covering the area of the Thale Noi Non-hunting Area, Khlong Yuan National Forest Reserve and Thung Sa public land. It was established in 1994

Received budget support from the Ministry of Natural Resources and Environment. Develop it into a full-fledged tourist attraction, constructing a 930-meter walking path to study nature, forests, and wildlife. Along the walkway, pavilions, parking ramp, and lake view point have also been built.
